



# Cedar County Board Minutes



July 24, 2018

The Cedar County Commissioners met in the Boardroom of the Cedar County Courthouse at 8:30 am and the meeting was called to order as advertised, with Craig Bartels, David McGregor and Terry Pinkelman answering roll call. Also present County Clerk David Dowling. Chairman McGregor stated the open meetings laws are posted on the wall for public inspection.

Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by Bartels to approve the agenda. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Motion was made by Bartels and seconded by Pinkelman to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Road Supt., Carla Schmidt presented a resolution for project STWD-CBMP (1) which is shared Wayne County. Motion by Bartels and seconded by McGregor to sign resolution 18-4 and all voting in favor; motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Motion by McGregor and seconded by Pinkelman to sign and approve resolution 18-5 to proceed with a road closing in precinct nine. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Discussion was held on getting the inventory updated on equipment and vehicles.

Peggy Leiting representing Randolph library and Tami Anderson representing Hartington library met with the board to discuss library service within the county presenting information on the service that is being provided to residents within the county. Peggy and Tami both thanked the commissioners for the past support and asked that the board continue with support, so the programs being offered can be continued. They stated that if the board of commissioners can provide the same amount as last year they would greatly appreciate it. The board agreed to the request and stated the same amount will be budgeted again this year for the libraries.

At 10AM engineering proposals were reviewed with three engineering firms for a flood damage project in Cedar County. Proposals were for engineering a repair on a road slide caused from recent storms. Motion was made by McGregor and seconded by Bartels to accept the bid from Maineli Wagner and Associates Engineering firm for the project. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Assessor, Don Hoesing presented a list of properties that were recently changed on the tax roll. Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by Bartels to approve tax corrections on the following properties: 139, 139.02, 256.02, 588, 977, 979, 981, 1250, 1256, 1257, 1417, 1582.06, 1681, 1683, 1686, 1963, 3197, 4069, 4070, 5894, 6089, 6124, 6257, 6258, 5705.01, 6969, 7013, 7548, 7562, 7565.01, 7567, 7568, 7571.01, 7573, 6998, 6296, 6457, 6207.01, 6431, and 7017. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

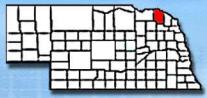

Sudbeck presented a building for Curt Hjorth to build a cabin at the sportsmen area on a lot. Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by McGregor to approve the permit as presented. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Sudbeck then presented a building permit from Larry Tweedy to build a 40 x 26 cabin in the Ponderosa acres lot 25. Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by McGregor to approve. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Building permit from Joe Tramp for a 40 x 80 machine shed. Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by McGregor to approve. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Building permit from Jeff Thies for a 60 x 96 shop was reviewed. Motion by Bartels and seconded by McGregor to approve. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Building permit from Ryan Meyer for a trailer house was presented. Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by Bartels to approve. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Motion was made by McGregor and seconded by Pinkelman to approve special designated liquor license for Nissen Wine for an event at the Kruse Stain Glass Workshop on October 13 and 14 of this year. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

With no further business or agenda items the chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
