



# Cedar County Board Minutes



September 25, 2018

The Cedar County Commissioners met in the Boardroom of the Cedar County Courthouse at 8:30 am and the meeting was called to order as advertised, with Craig Bartels, David McGregor and Terry Pinkelman answering roll call. Also present County Clerk David Dowling. Chairman McGregor stated the open meetings laws are posted on the wall for public inspection.

Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by Bartels to approve the agenda. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Motion was made by Bartels and seconded by Pinkelman to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Road Supt., Carla Schmidt presented one underground application for Great Plains for district one approval. Application was signed by commissioner Pinkelman. Motion was made by McGregor and seconded by Bartels to approve and sign resolution 18-7 relating to FEMA project east of Hartington. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Schmidt then presented the bids for the bridge project in Cedar County that is going to be let with Stanton County. Motion was made by McGregor and seconded by Bartels to accept the bid from Theisen Construction from Norfolk. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Schmidt then presented a list of structurally deficient bridges in each respective district listed from bad to worse condition.

Dave Sudbeck presented a building permit for Tony Walz for a 60,000 - bushel bin. Motion was made by Bartels and seconded by McGregor. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Building permit for Tim Schroeder for a 60 x 80 building. Motion by Pinkelman and seconded by McGregor to approve the permit. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Next a permit was presented for Jason Merkel for a 280 x 78 building. Motion by Pinkelman and seconded Bartels to approve the permit. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Motion was made by Pinkelman and seconded by McGregor to approve an SDL for All Saints Church of Northeast Nebraska for an event October 27 at the St Boniface Parish Center. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Motion by McGregor and seconded by Bartels to go into Board of Equalization to review levies for 2018. After reviewing the levies as presented a motion was made by McGregor to approve and set the levies for 2018. Voting in favor were commissioners Bartels, McGregor and Pinkelman, motion carried 3 to 0.

Pinkelman reported on recent NorthStar Mental Health and Disabilities meeting he attended in Norfolk, stating the organization is having financial problems that will get worse in the next few years. McGregor reported on recent Area on Aging board meeting he attended in Norfolk. Bartels reported on an RC& D meeting he attended in Plainview.

John Thelen met with board to discuss statute 39-1702 and asked about having the County Attorney check into the statute and make a reply on his request. Chairman McGregor told Mr. Thelen that the County Attorney will be contacted and get back to him.

With no further business or agenda items the chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
